Leadership Program

The Sault Area Chamber of Commerce Leadership Program is designed to bring a group of diverse individuals together to undergo a series of educational sessions where they will become knowledgeable on topics that impact and define our community. These individuals are recognized as potential leaders in the community and will be equipped with information, resources and relationships to help shape the future of the Sault Ste. Marie area.

Applicants will be selected on the basis of community involvement, career background, work experience, motivation, attitude and leadership potential.

The objective of the Leadership Program is to:

- Identify participants who hold potential for community leadership
- Provide these leaders with community issues, resources and opportunities
- Increase the leadership skills of program participants
- Provide participants with opportunities to exchange ideas with each other and community leaders
- Encourage graduates to continue their community involvement and leadership in the Sault area

This 9-month program begins with a retreat weekend and continues monthly with a full day's session on given topics and wraps up with a development plan day. Graduation from the program will take place at the Chamber's Annual Dinner & Awards Banquet in February 2019. Each month, information will be presented from area professionals on the specified topic. Each session offers a variety of information, tours, hands-on experience and gives the participants an opportunity to interact with community leaders.

- Thursday, January 10, 2019 – Wrap Up/Development Plan
